Holly Beach Farm is a 300-acre coastal resource characterized by wetland-dominated natural areas, complex vegetative diversity, abundant wildlife, and five miles of tidal shoreline on the Chesapeake Bay and Whitehall Bay. Originally a farm with historic and cultural values, the property was placed in conservation 20 years ago and managed under the Chesapeake Bay Foundation's (CBF) care.

The proposed stewardship plan is a multi-faceted proposal integrating innovative offshore and land-based methods to preserve and celebrate the coastline, layered history, and many ecosystems on Holly Beach Farm. During this stewardship, Holly Beach Farm will operate as the region's environmental, educational, and climate change research hub.






